JA Colonel Henry Crown Scholarships (\$60,000)

Deadline

• Wednesday, April 15, 2026 (4) Scholarships to be Awarded

Award

- \$60,000 Scholarship (\$15,000/year for a four-year period while pursuing a degree at an accredited college or university of your choice)
- Paid attendance at a summer internship program (3 summers at 10 weeks each) with a Colonel Henry Crown affiliated company or an agency supported by Crown Family Philanthropies.

Eligibility Criteria

- · Must be a high school senior who has an average of "B" or better beginning in your sophomore year
- Must have participated in two or more Junior Achievement high school programs
- Applicants need to submit a completed Colonel Henry Crown application
- Finalists must be available Tuesday, April 21 through Friday, April 24 for a 25-minute virtual interview to determine the scholarship recipients.
- Finalists must submit a brief JA experience video by Friday, April 24 following this link: https://drive.google.com/drive/folders/105qH2hC9CKxtBgJmtb2ogaHWm_S2dBX5

Scholarship Recipients will be notified by Wednesday, May 6 AND must be available Tuesday, May 19 for the award announcement at the Junior Achievement Board of Directors' Meeting to be held at the Union League Club at 65 W. Jackson Blvd., Chicago from 11:00-1:00 pm.

<u>JA General Scholarships (\$1,000-\$5,000)</u>

Deadline

Wednesday, April 15, 2026 – Multiple/Various Scholarships Awarded

Award

• Scholarships ranging from \$1,000-\$5,000 as a one-time payment to the college or university of your choice.

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be a high school senior who has an average of "B" or better beginning in your sophomore year
- Must have participated in two or more Junior Achievement programs at some point during your academic career (elementary school, middle school or high school)
- General Scholarship recipients are determined utilizing the Colonel Henry Crown application as well; Please submit a completed Colonel Henry Crown application and all of its required attachments
- Students who wish to be considered for the \$2,500 Sandy Dafféé Future Leader Scholarship should also complete the required essay supplement

JA Company Program Scholarships (\$2,000 - \$3,000)

Deadline

• Wednesday, April 15, 2026

Award

• (1) \$3,000 and (1) \$2,000 Awarded

Eligibility Criteria

- Application link will open March 4, 2026
- Must be a high school senior who participated in the JA Company Program, JA Company Program Pop-Up.
- Applicants need to submit the Student Scholarship Essay and Application

JA High School Heroes Scholarships (\$1,000)

Deadline

• Wednesday, April 15, 2026

Award

Multiple/Various Scholarships Awarded

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be a high school senior who participated as a High School Heroes volunteer twice in which you trained and facilitated a Junior Achievement program in a local elementary classroom serving as the volunteer.
- · Applicants need to submit an essay detailing their experience





Colonel Henry Crown Scholarship Fund

The fund will be used to provide a scholarship program for qualified Chicago area youth and will be administered by Junior Achievement. The program, supported by the Fund, will provide:

- 1. \$60,000 Scholarship (\$15,000 per year for a four-year period while pursuing a degree at an accredited college or university of your choice.)
- 2. Opportunity to apply for paid internships (3 summers at 10 weeks each) with a nonprofit organization supported by Crown Family Philanthropies. The goal is to place the student winners in a situation that best fits the students and supporting organization's needs.
- Applicants for the Henry Crown Scholarship must be a current senior, participated in two or more Junior Achievement high school programs and be recommended by their teacher and/or Junior Achievement volunteer.
- Children of Junior Achievement of Chicago full or part time employees are not eligible to be considered for the Henry Crown Scholarship.
- Applicants must have had an average of 3.0 on a scale of 4.0 or better, beginning in their sophomore year in high school, and shall furnish a complete, signed transcript of past and current high school class work. The results of SAT, ACT or PSAT college entrance exams shall be included, if available. Scholastic promise, motivation, moral character, leadership qualities and good citizenship are the major considerations for the selection of awardees.
- Applicants should submit a personal essay, enumerating his/her reasons for desiring to continue their education and their future goals. Applicants will be selected on an objective and non-discriminatory basis.
- Applications should include evidence of acceptance or tentative acceptance at an institution of higher learning
 of their choice. Grant money will be disbursed directly to the institution in payment towards qualified required
 educational expenses, including tuition and required fees.
- Finalists must be available Tuesday, April 21 through Friday, April 24 for a 25-minute virtual interview to determine the scholarship recipients. Finalists must submit a brief JA experience video by Friday, April 24 following this link:

- The following information is required to be considered for the Colonel Henry Crown Scholarship:
- 1. Completed Henry Crown Application
- 2.JA Volunteer or Classroom Teacher Rating Scale
- 3. High School Rating Scale
- 4.Transcript
- 5.SAT/ACT or PSAT Scores
- 6.Letter of Recommendation
- 7.Student Essay detailing reason(s) for wanting to continue education and future goals
- 8. Letter of Acceptance from College/University





The Sandy Daffé Future Leader Scholarship

Supplementary Essay Prompts

- All high school seniors who wish to be considered for The Sandy Daffé Future Leader Scholarship must complete this essay supplement, in addition to the Colonel Henry Crown Scholarship application. Once submitted, Junior Achievement of Chicago will judge essays on content and form. The author of the top essay will receive a scholarship for \$2,500.
- On a separate page, please respond to one of the following prompts in 300-500 words:
- 1. Tell us about a favorite leader of yours, either historical or of the present. What made them so influential and why do you admire them?
- 2. Many great leaders are committed to their causes. Write about something that you feel passionately about and explain how you could lead others to care about your cause.
- 3. Write about a time that you took the lead. How did you react? What did you learn from the experience?
- 4. Do you think that leaders are born with the ability to lead, or do you think they develop their leadership skills? Why?

Eligibility Criteria

Only SENIOR students who participate in the JA Company Program are eligible to submit
and essay for consideration. Once submitted, Junior Achievement of Chicago will review
essays on content and form. The top 2 essays will receive either \$3,000 or \$2,000 furnished by
Discover Financial Services. Authors of the winning essays will be invited to attend the
Chicago Area Board of Directors Meeting on Tuesday, May 19, 2026, and may be asked to read
their winning essay at that time.

Essays should be type written, double spaced, 12-point font. Please attach completed essay behind a copy of this form and ensure that your first and last name, school name and JA Company name appear at the top of each page.
